Whatever! That guy behind us is haulin' fruit, 'cause he jus' **threw a pineapple!**

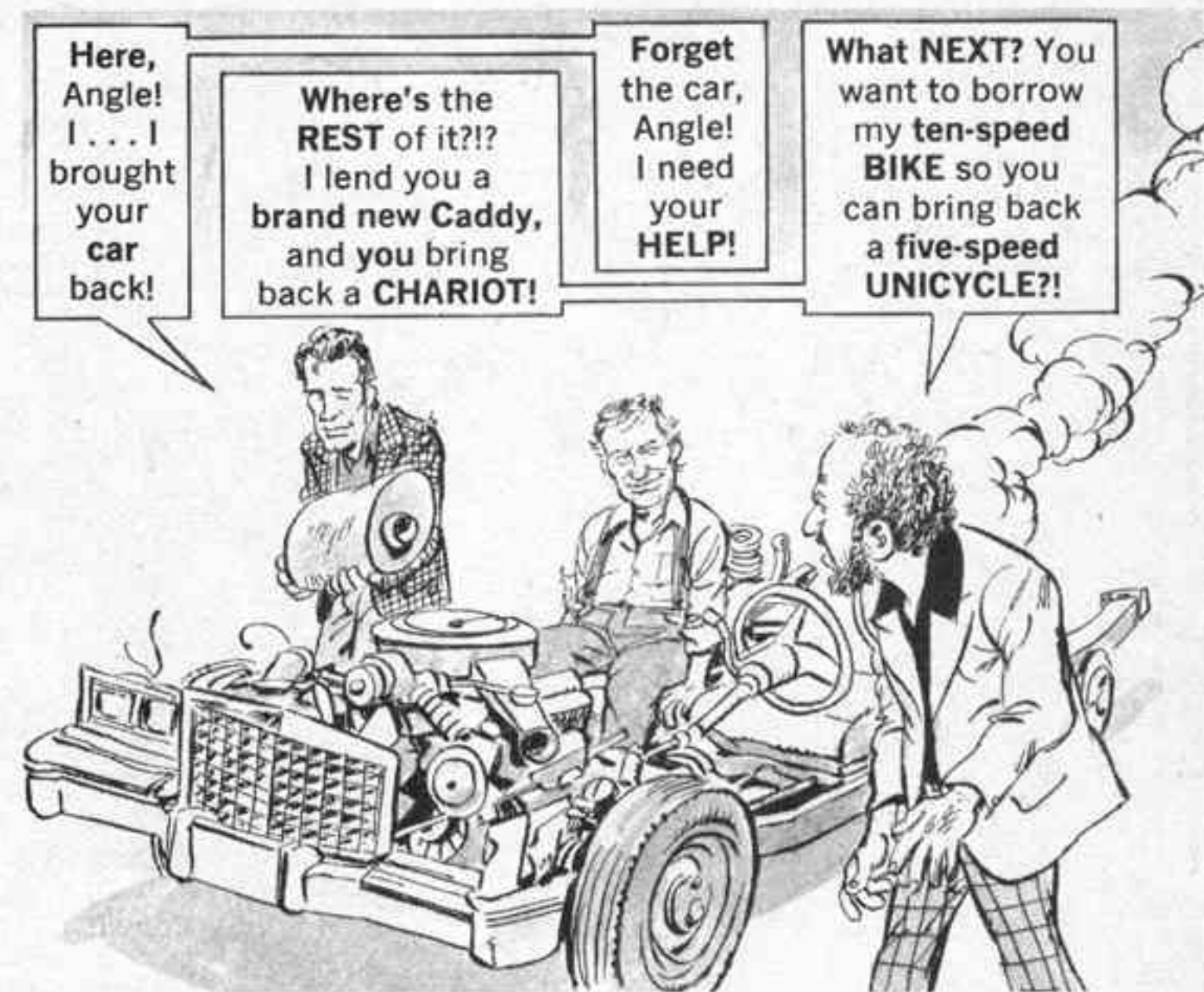
