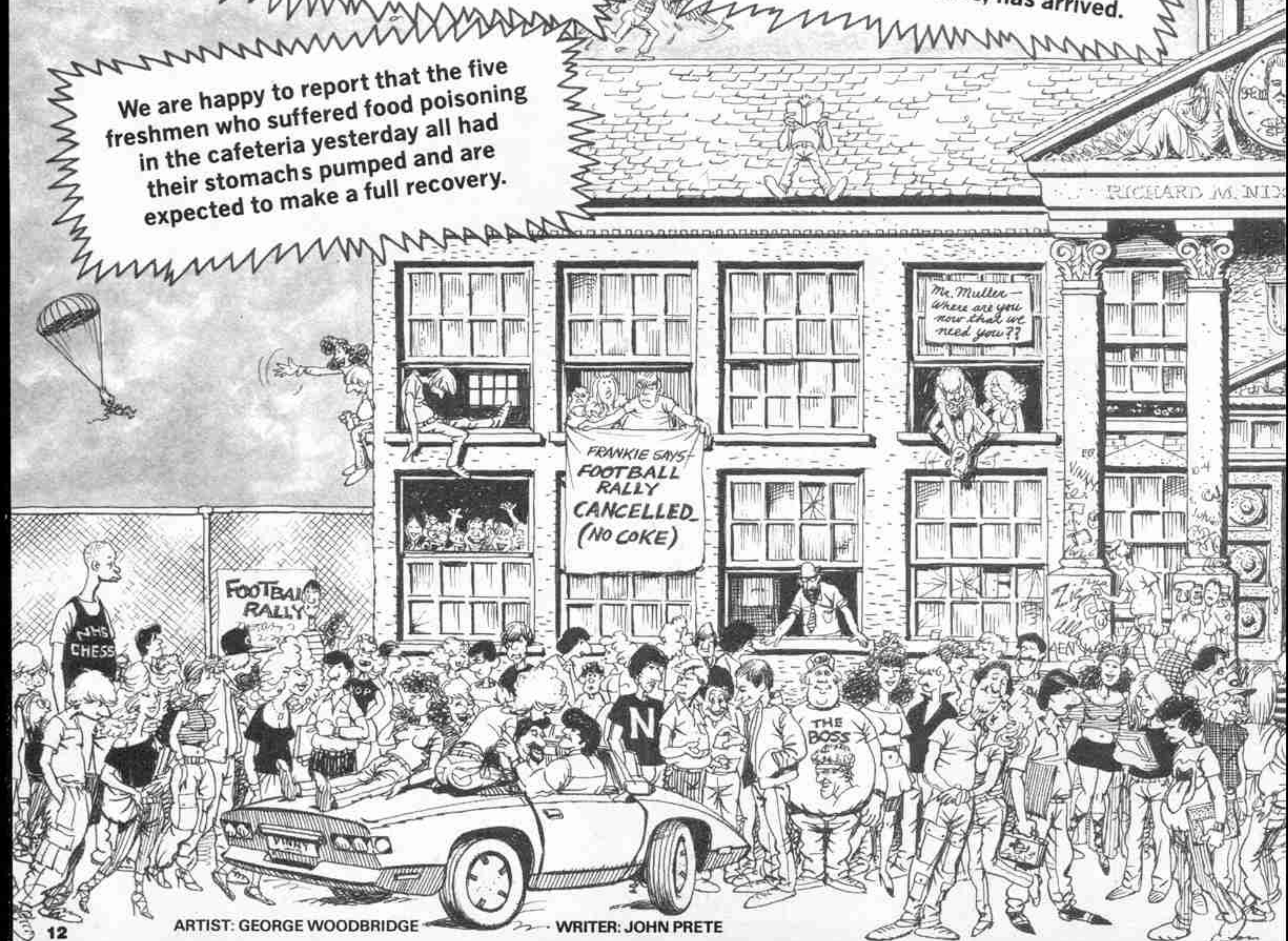
Last night the school board officially turned down a request by the student council to allow the serving of beer and tequila in the cafeteria. The vote was seven to six.

The FBI will resume questioning students today regarding the illegal use of the school's computer to alter faculty members' IRS records. Your cooperation is appreciated.

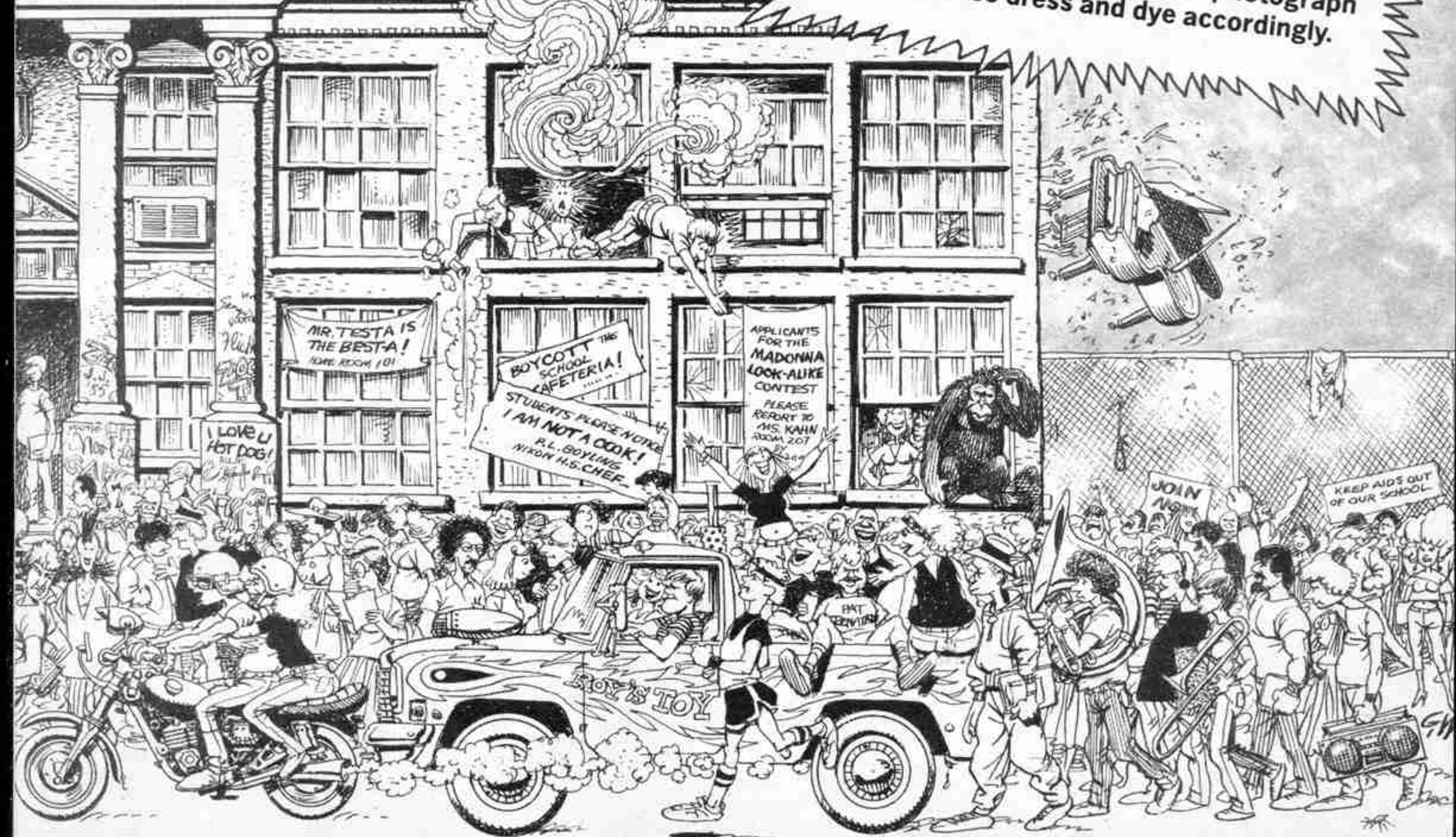
Results of the state-wide reading test are in. Congratulations to Junior Ray Hanrahan whose seventh grade reading level was the highest in the school.
