HOLLYWOOD, CA.—The accounting firm of Lice-Watermouse today launched a study of Academy Award voting procedures, following a memorable Oscar night in which the sleazy porno flick "Depraved Dallas Baton Twirlers" took top honors.

The film was named Best Picture of the year, in addition to winning Oscars for Best Costumes (even though nobody in the film wore any) and Best Script Written in Pencil on Three-Hole Looseleaf Paper. It is also believed to be the only film shot

Said Station Manager and former embezzler Boobing Tuber, "We decided to take a direct approach after we found that no amount of legitimate promotion would make the public watch our junky programs."

The ratings people became suspicious of the latest survey results when WTTT beat out "The Cosby Show" and "A Different World" with a rerun of "Seahunt" that Lloyd Bridges didn't even appear in.
