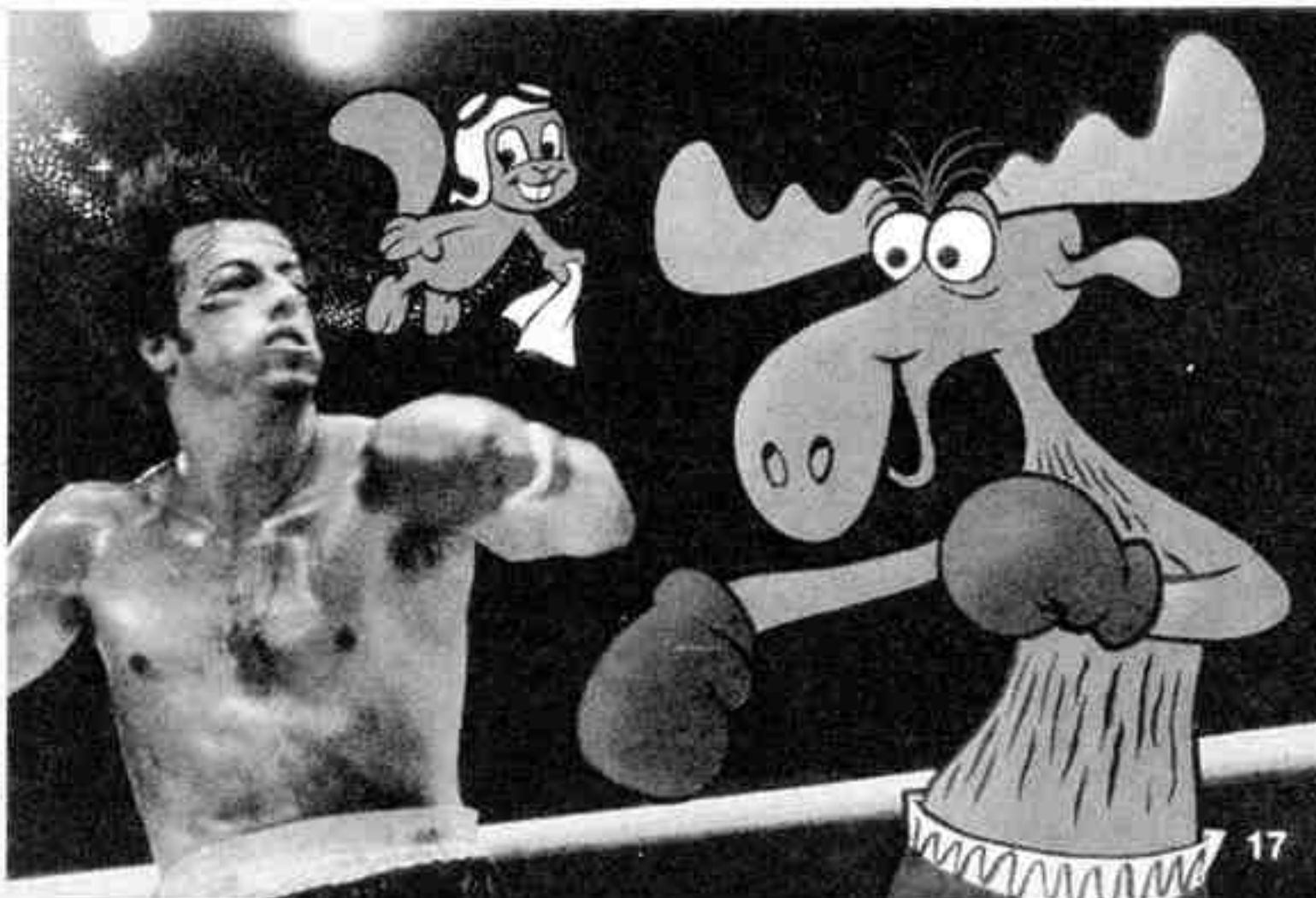


THREE MEN AND A BABY HERMAN

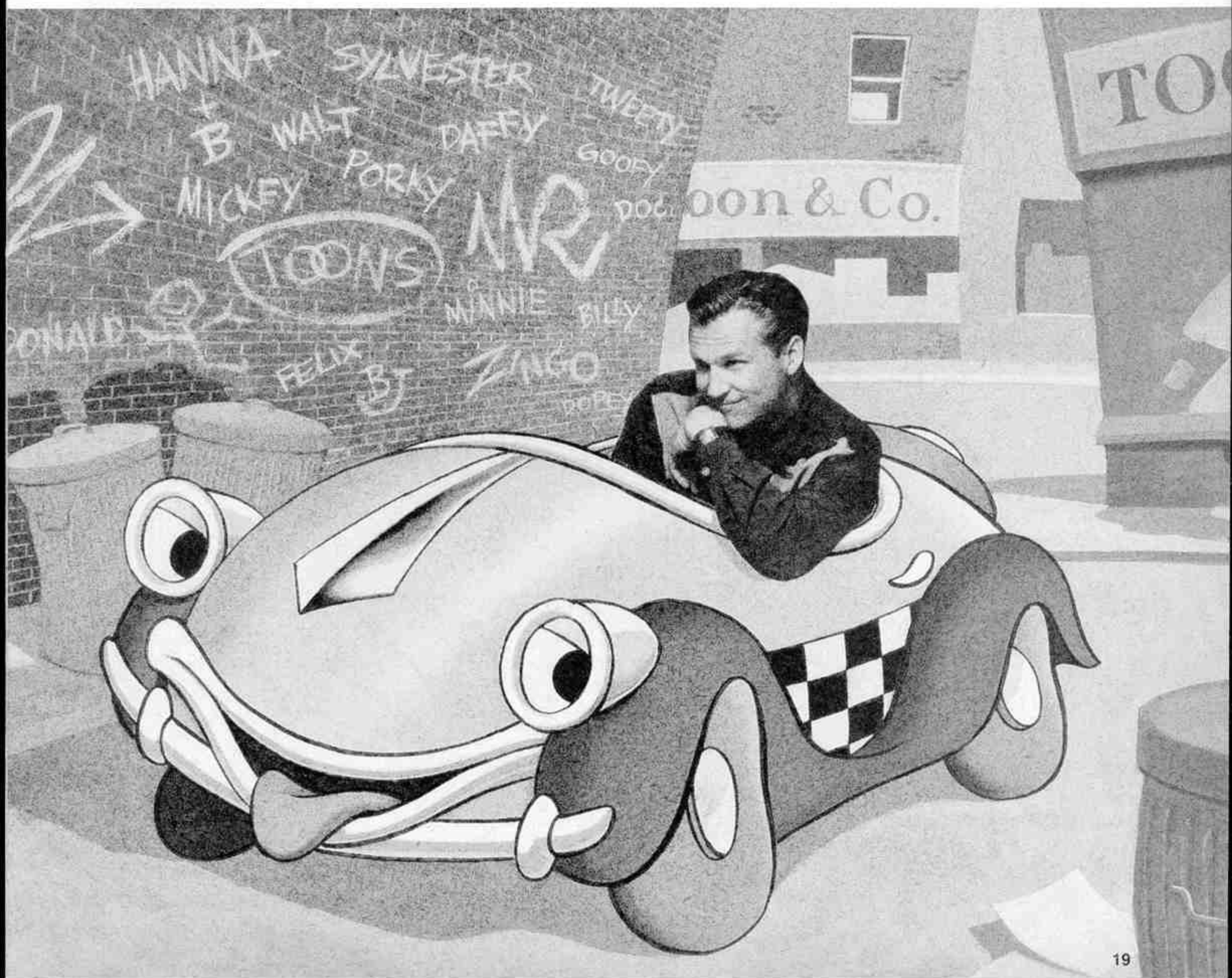
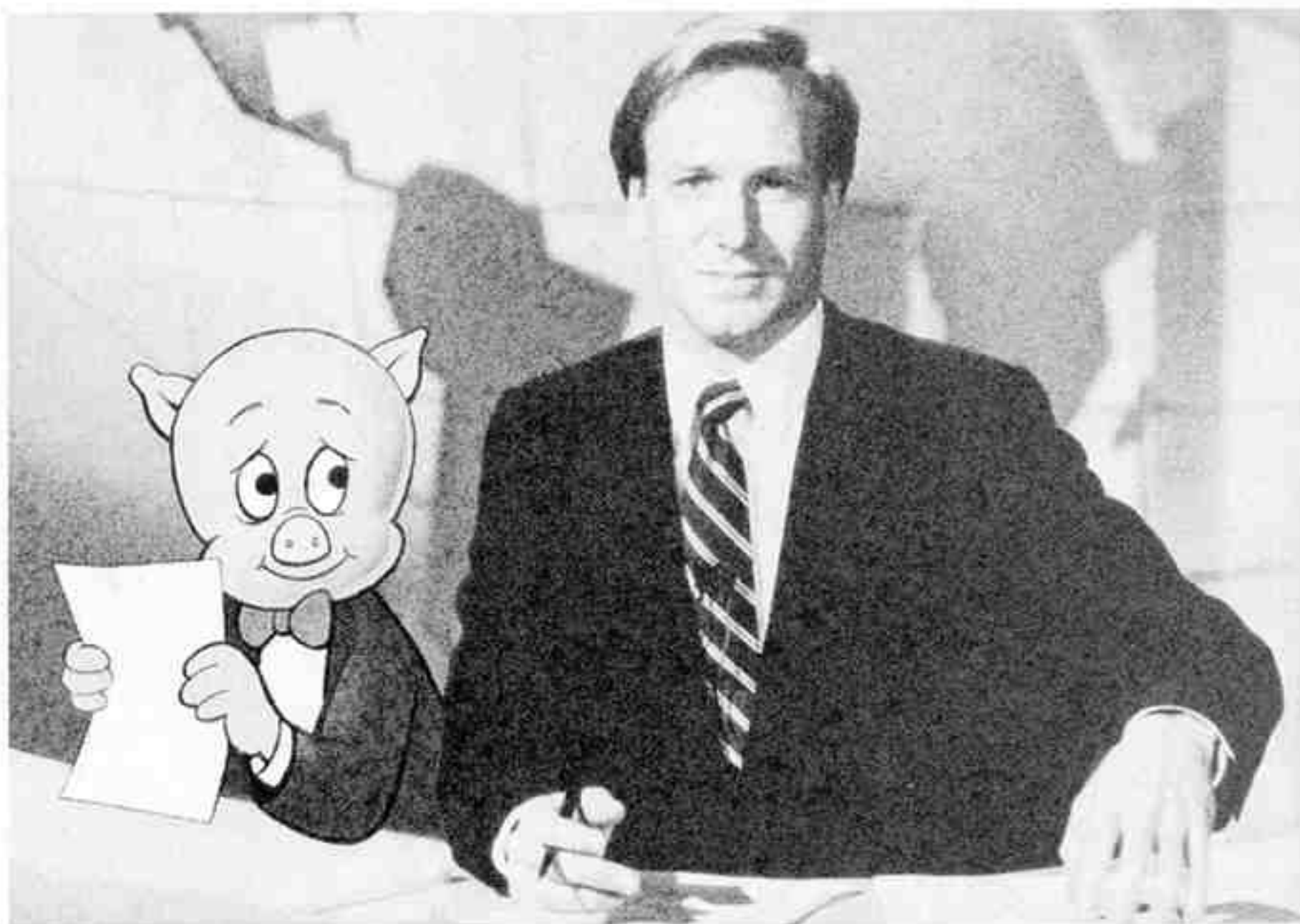
RETURN OF ALIEN 6

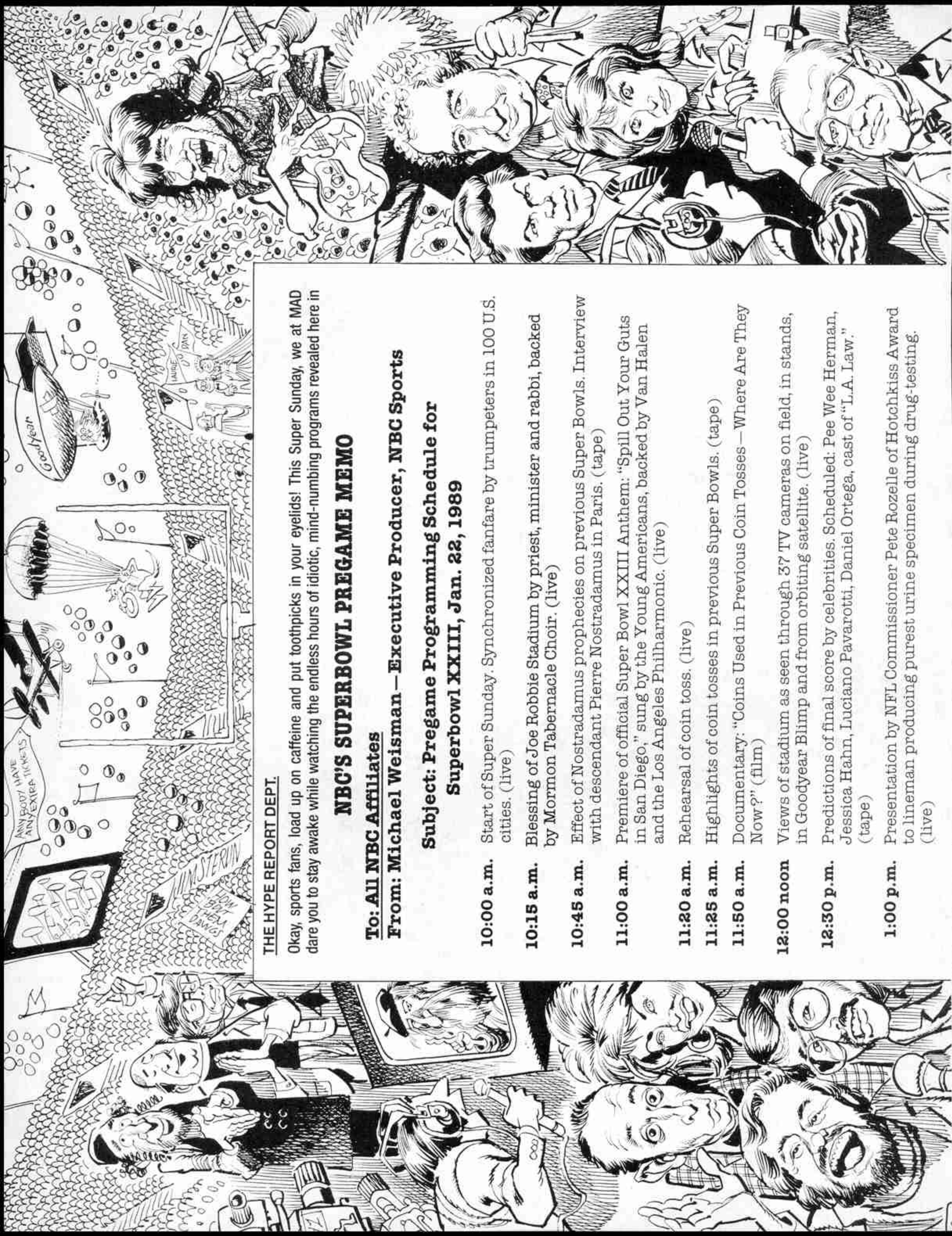
