I'll let him try it first! I've heard if you put an infinite number of jocks in a room with an infinite number of typewriters, eventually they'll write all the great books ever written!

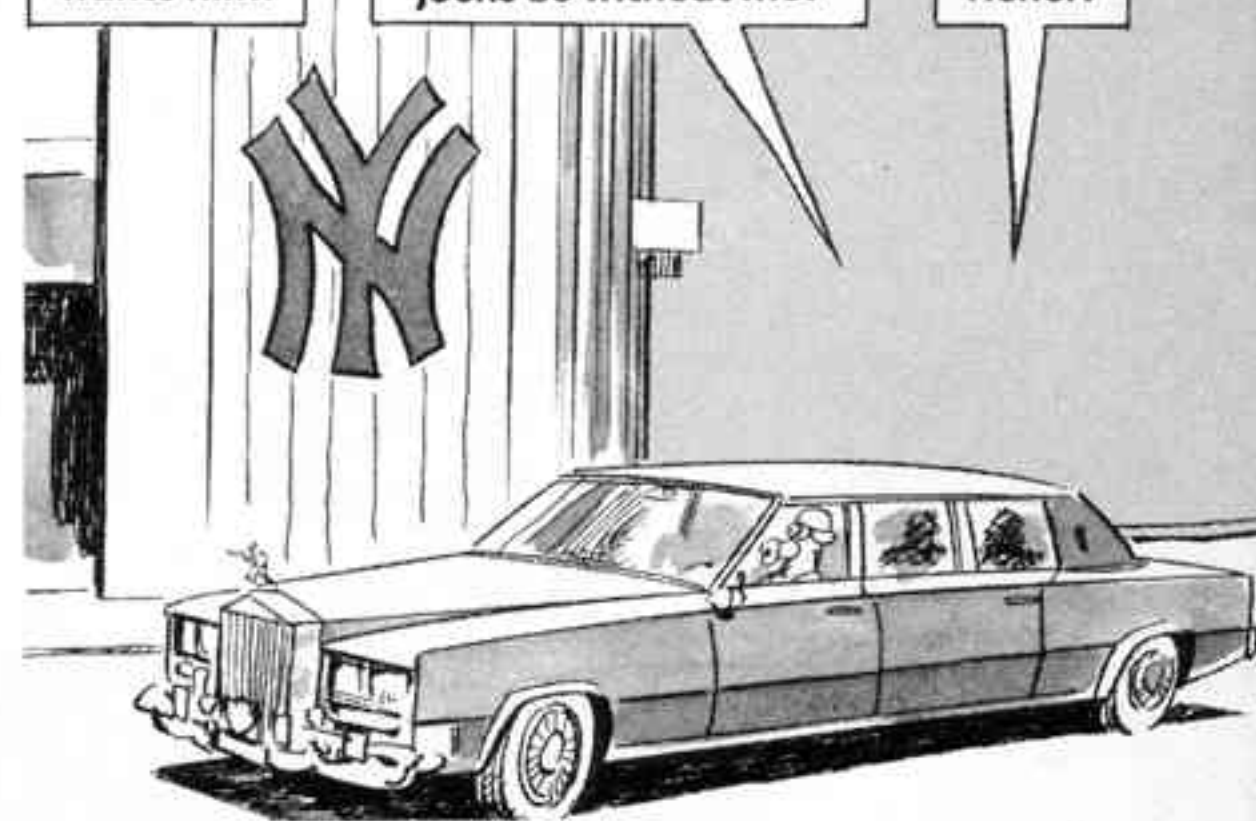
Sorry, that was monkeys, bub, not jocks!
