Sometime after she leaves Relative Obscurity and before she arrives in The Spotlight, she meets a Politician on the Rise.



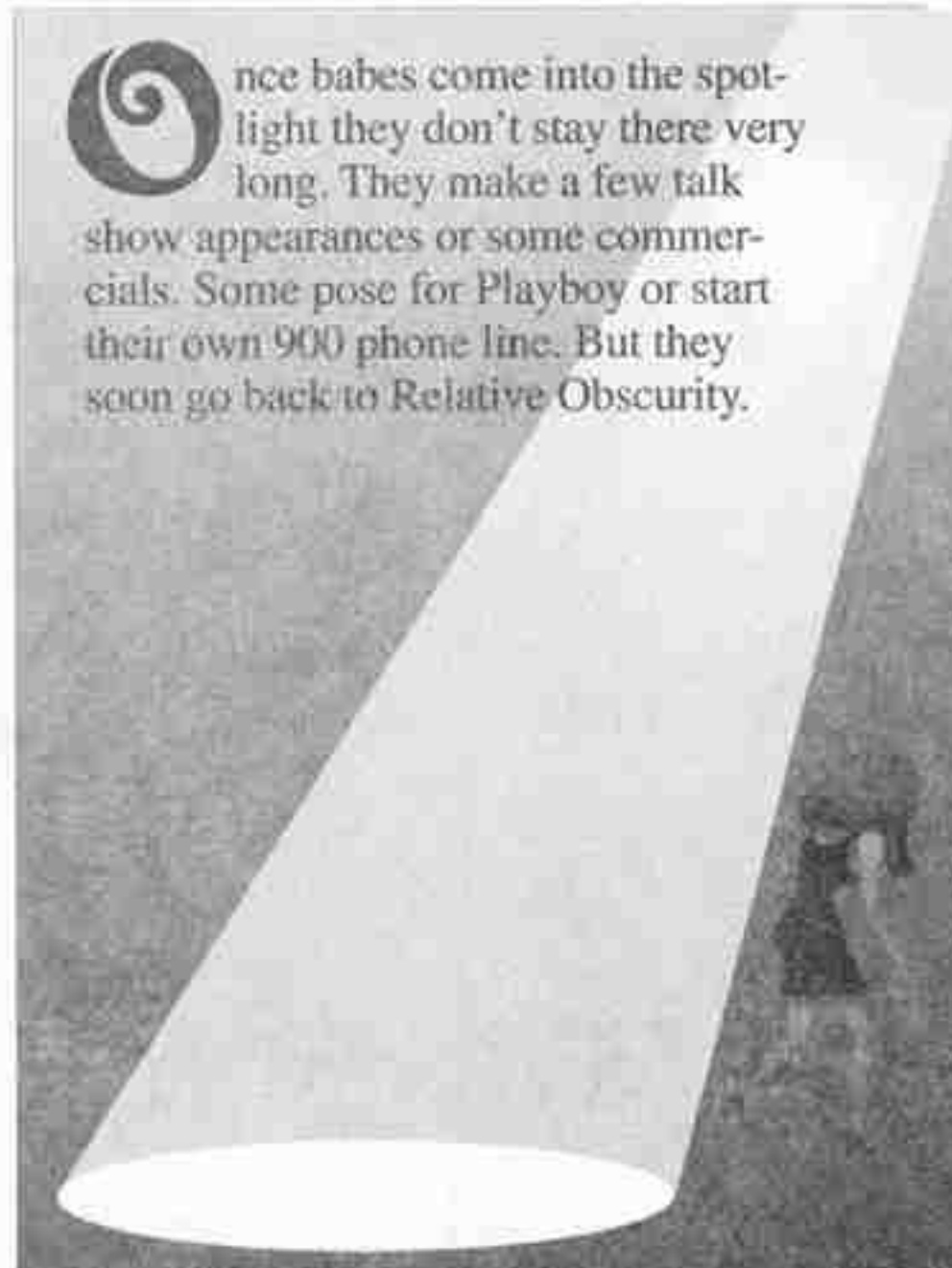

We give each of them a bullet proof vest for our riots, dehydrated food for our earthquakes and portable oxygen for our frequent third stage smog alerts!



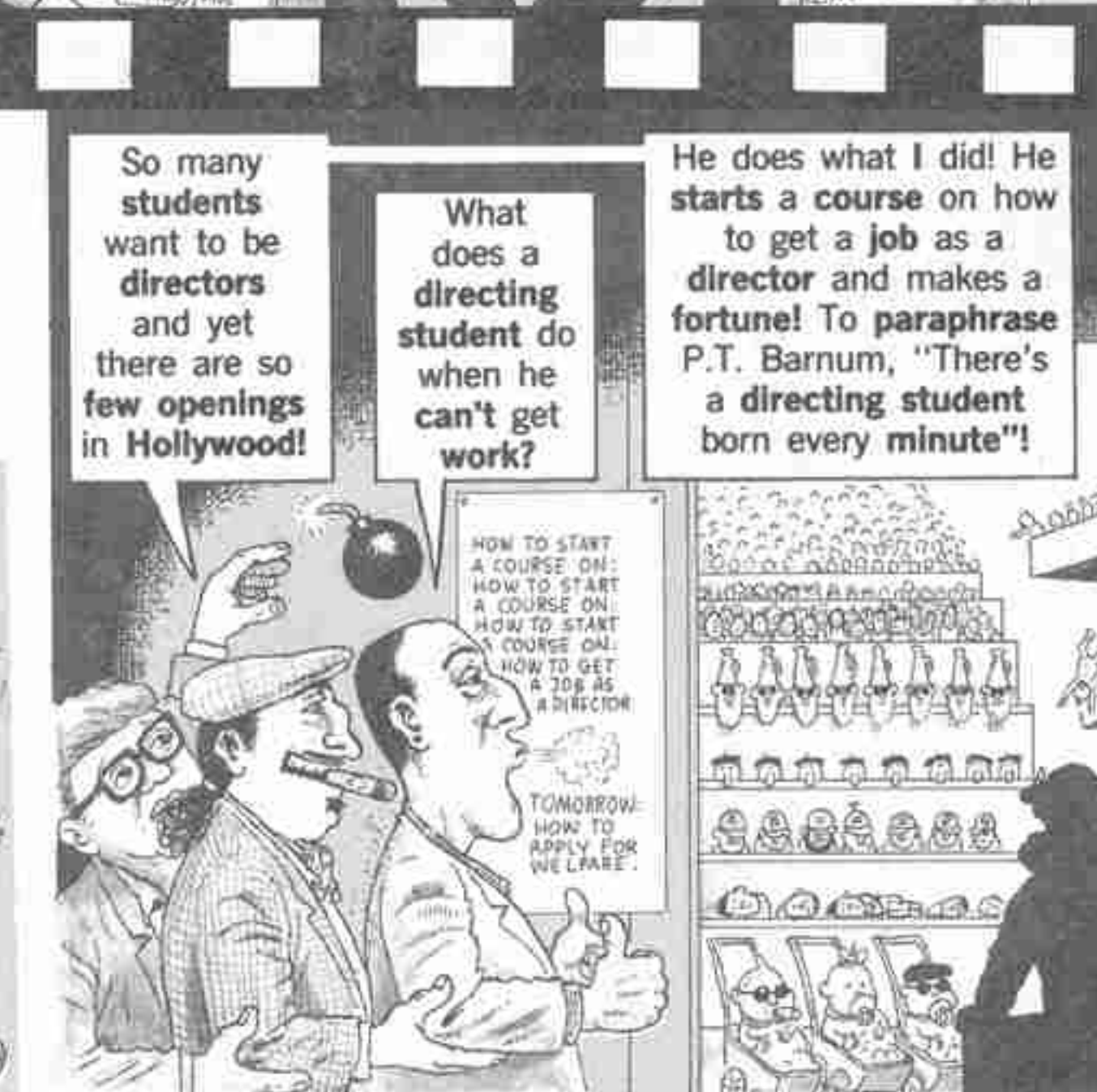
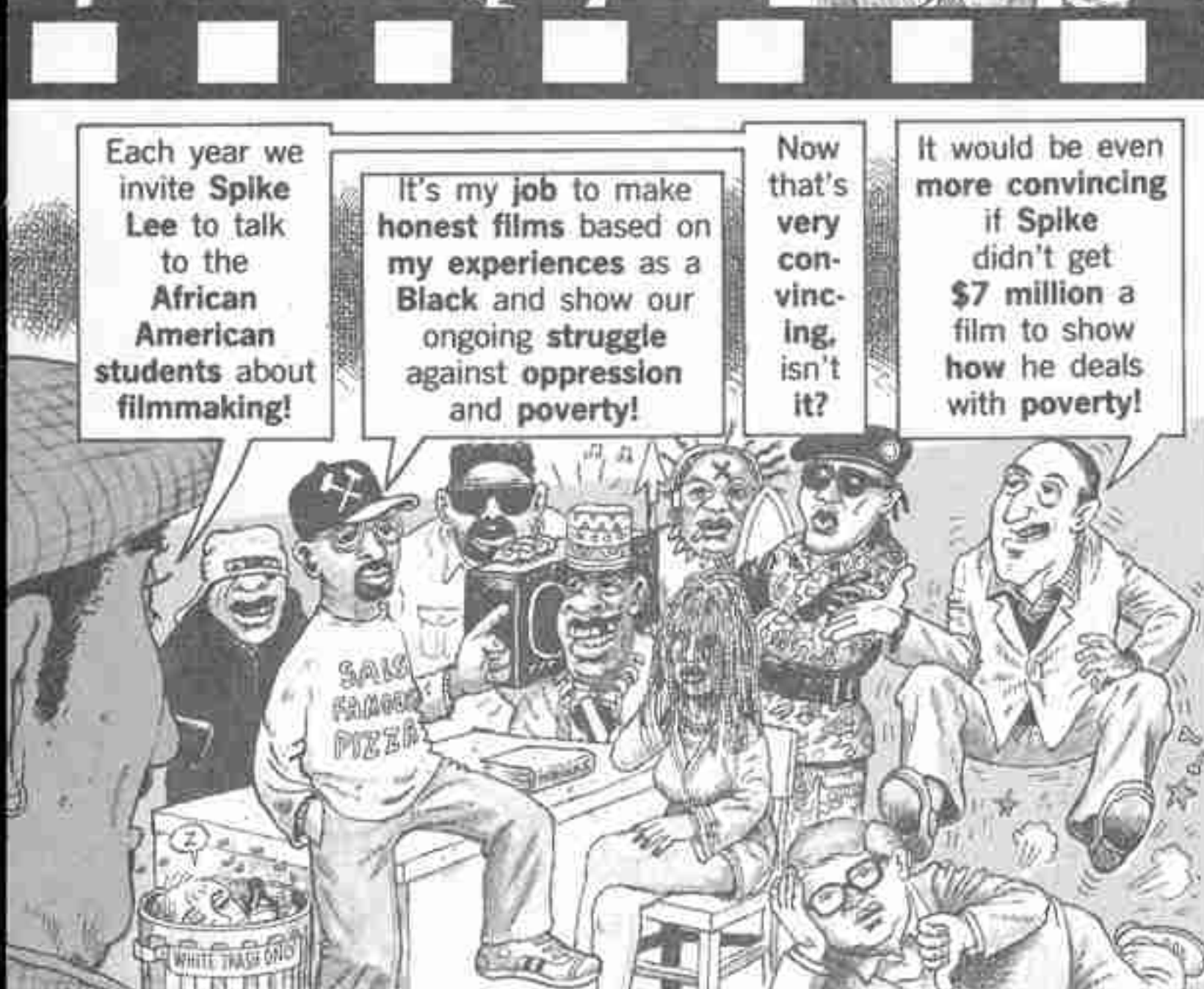
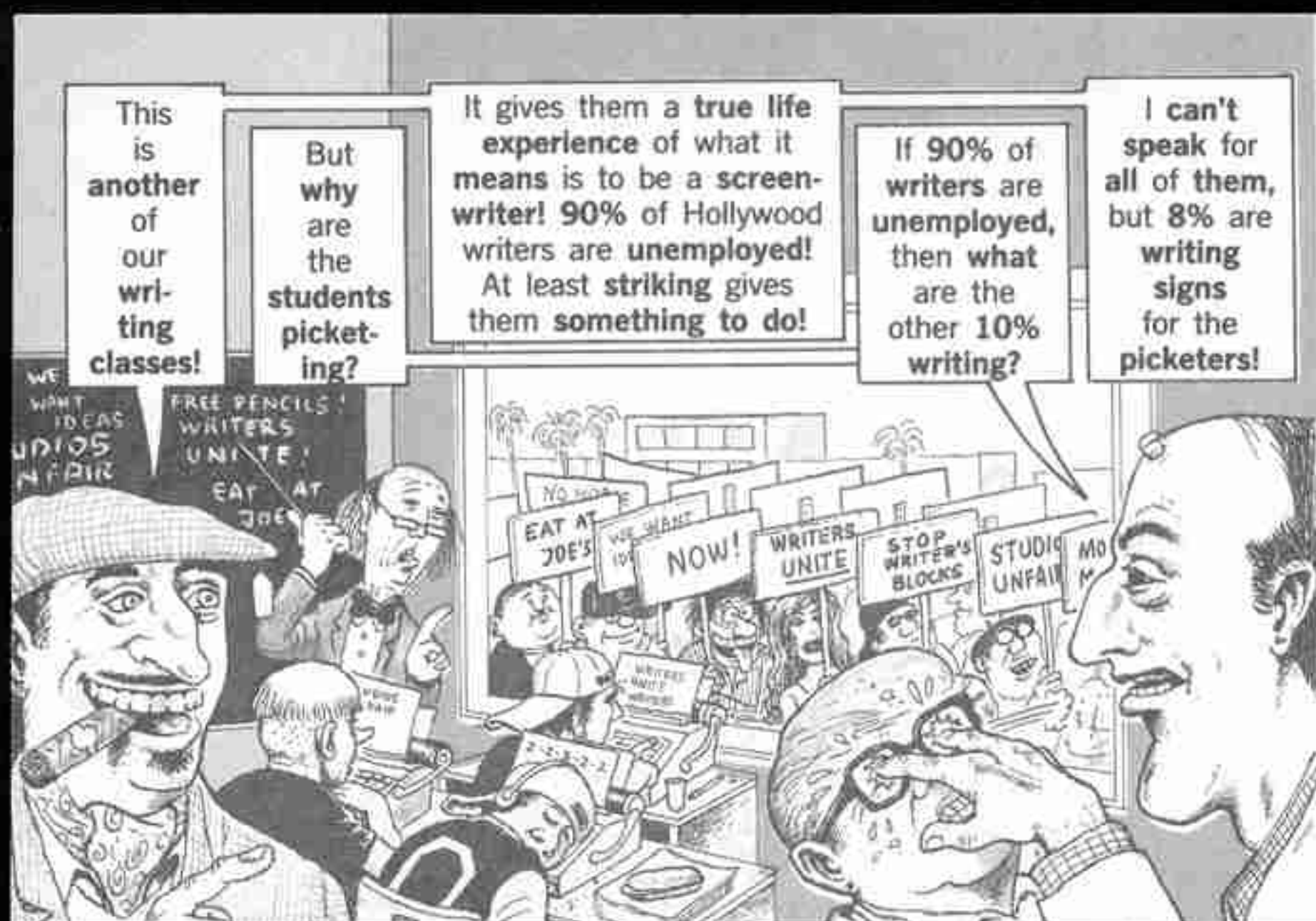
What class is this?
