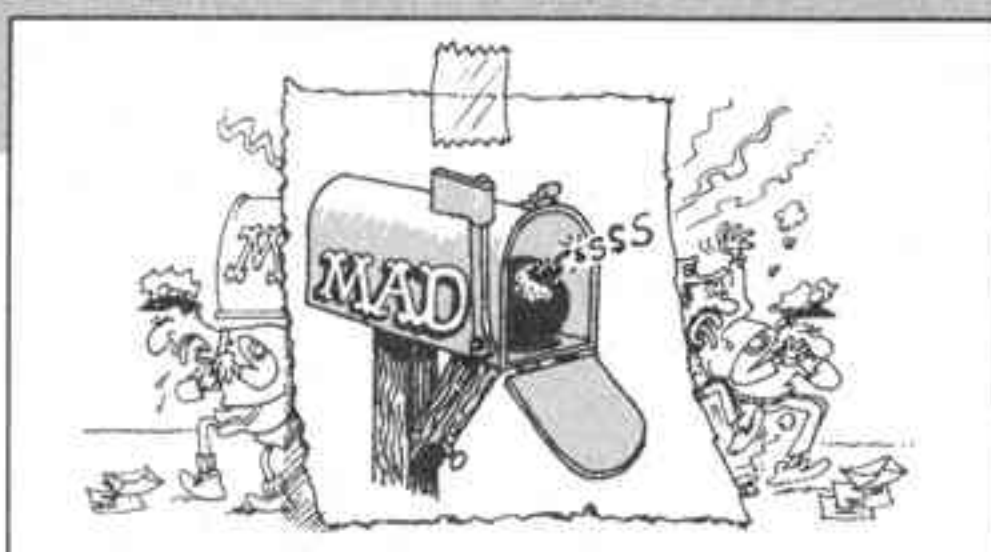


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POLITICALLY MAD

Put it this way: right now you're not in this opening splash panel! You're actually on the last page!

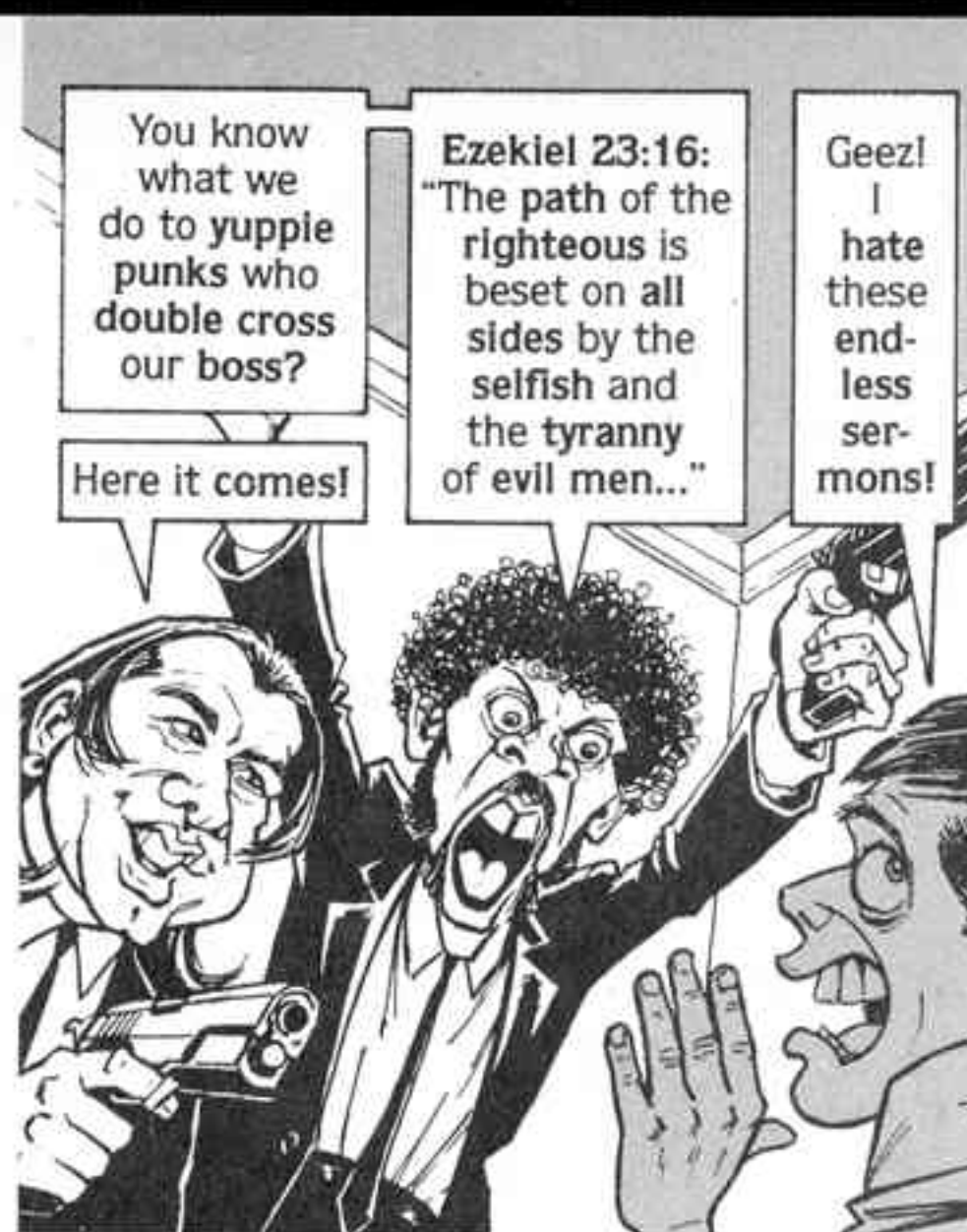
